

**HARDWARE AND SOFTWARE INSTALLATION REQUIREMENTS**

**Phoenix NP Complete<sup>®</sup>** provides for multi-user access capabilities complete with role-based security. To ensure all users have access to the application, the software is installed on local user computers, with the data files stored on a central computer (server) that all local computers can have full read and write access to. With this type of installation, **Phoenix NP Complete<sup>®</sup>** will work equally well on wired, wireless, or combination networks (wired recommended wherever appropriate). The local computers and central computer (server) should be sufficiently robust units with the following minimum specifications:

CPU – dual core PC minimum recommended

RAM – 3 Gb minimum recommended

HDD – 250 Gb minimum recommended

O/S – Windows 7 or higher (client); Windows Server 2008 or higher recommended (server)

Software – Microsoft Office Professional 2010 (including Microsoft Access) or higher required, with all current Windows and Office updates downloaded and installed.

Minimum of Microsoft<sup>®</sup> SQL Server<sup>®</sup> 2008 R2 SP1 - Express Edition (if implementing the Course, Grade, Report Card Module)

Typical server preparation, in advance of **Phoenix NP Complete<sup>®</sup>** installation, requires the creation of a “file share” entitled “SPG”, into which the software files will be copied. All users who will be accessing **Phoenix NP Complete<sup>®</sup>** will require full read and write privileges for this file share. Installation of the software on both client and central computers is typically accommodated via remote desktop connection (where appropriate).

**Please note that *Phoenix NP Complete<sup>®</sup>* cannot be installed if any of the above minimum hardware or software requirements are not met.**
